Stabling for one show day:	\$50 (from 11:30am the day before to 11:59pm the day of) All horses must occupy a stall per NEC contract.
Stabling for both show days:	\$75 (from 11:30am the day before to 11:59pm the day of) All horses must occupy a stall per NEC contract.
Jump Out Fee for horses already stabled at the NEC:	\$25/show day - Only available if already stabling at the NEC with the NEC's USEF Western Dressage Show. (Please list under "stabling" on entry form)
Tack Stall for one show day:	\$35 (from 11:30am the day before to 11:59pm the day of)
Tack Stall for both show days:	\$65
Shavings:	\$9.00 per bale. Outside bedding is not permitted and two bags minimum (not included) must be purchased per facility contract.

### **Team Challenge Guidelines:**

For competitors entered in both Saturday and Sunday only. Each team can consist of 2-6 riders and can be any combination of Jr/YR, AA, and Open. All the scores from both days will be averaged together to comprise the score for each team. The team with the highest average will win the Team Challenge. Medals will be awarded on Sunday following the last ride. Each team member must pay the \$5.00 Team Challenge Fee. If you are unable to fill a team but would like to take part in the Team Challenge, please make note of this on your entry and we will do our best to help you put one together.

- -If mailing entries, please make checks (no credit cards) out to "SLADS" and mail to Lindsey Culver, 108 Desert Willow Ct, Wentzville, MO 63385.

- -The 2019 USDF and USEF Dressage will be used for all tests,
- https://www.usdf.org/downloads/forms/2019.asp. The most recently published USEF Western Dressage tests will be used and are available at http://westerndressageassociation.org/wdaa-tests/. 2018 USEA Eventing Dressage Tests are available at https://useventing.com/events-competitions/resources/dressage-tests
- -Informal attire (including paddock boots and half chaps) allowed. All riders must wear competition-appropriate headgear.
- -All USEF/USDF dressage tests to be ridden in a plain snaffle, except Third Level or above, where full bridle is optional.
- -A copy of negative Coggins test, dated within one year, must be submitted with entry.
- -Copy of Vaccination Record (FLU/RHINO) within 6 months must be submitted with entry.
- -Health Certificate for out of state horses only, written within 15 days, to be shown at check in.
- -Refunds, less office fee, can be given before closing date. No refunds of any kind will be given for any reason (including with vet note) after the closing date.
- -Ride times and stabling assignments will be posted http://dressage.startboxscoring.com/showsu/slads/ds0719 2-4 days before the show.
- -Live scoring during the show will be available at <a href="http://dressage.startboxscoring.com/showsu/slads/ds0719">http://dressage.startboxscoring.com/showsu/slads/ds0719</a>
  -Dressage Suitability class is open to horses and riders of all ages and will be ridden in a group. To be shown at the walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring when asked by the judge. To be judged on the horse's potential to become a Dressage mount. This class will not be divided or placed in separate divisions.
- -Dressage Seat Equitation classes will be shown at the medium walk, working trot and canter both ways of the ring when asked by the judge. The rider's position, seat and specifically the correct use and effect of the
- aids required by Training Level will be judged.
- -Depending on the amount of participants, the Dressage Seat Equitation class may be
- shown together in the same group but will be placed in separate divisions, Jr/YR and AA. Western Dressage and Gaited Dressage may also enter this class.
- -USDF Materiale class is for 3-5 year old horses and will be shown together as a group, except if a stallion is present. To be
- shown at the walk, trot and canter both ways of the ring when asked by the judge. Mares may not compete under saddle or
- in Materiale classes after their eighth month of pregnancy or within three months after foaling.
- -For the Trainer In Your Ear TOC class, your trainer may talk to you through your tests using a coaching device or cell phone with Bluetooth.
- -For all TOC classes, riders may enter more than one test. Please specify tests on your entry form.
- -If wanting scores to count towards SLADS YEA, rider and owner must be a member of SLADS and horse must be nominated for awards with SLADS.
- -If wanting scores to count towards the NEC/SLADS High Point Awards Series, Rider must nominate themselves with the NEC and pay a \$5 nomination fee to the NEC. -Ribbons through sixth place for all classes.
- -TIP Recognized (thoroughbred incentive program): Horses to be verified at time of entry or on site with copy of Jockey Club papers or photograph of lip tattoo.
