CLASSES: Class numbers 101-122 will be held on Saturday October 26th. Class numbers 201-222 will be held on Sunday October 27th.

ARENA: The standard (large) arena will be used for all classes. Schooling *will* be allowed in the competition arena prior to the beginning of the show and during breaks. Horses *will* be allowed in the competition arena during warm-up immediately preceding their scheduled ride times. Both competition and warm-up arenas are indoors with climate control.

RULES AND REGULATIONS

- 1. Except where otherwise noted, USEF/USDF and MHSA rules will apply
- 2. No braiding (unless you really want to).
- 3. Informal attire (including paddock boots and half chaps) is allowed. All riders must wear competition-appropriate headgear. Helmets *highly* recommended for **all** classes.
- 4. The 2019 USDF and USEF Dressage tests will be used for all dressage classes and are available at https://www.usdf.org/downloads/forms/index.asp?TypePass=Tests. The most recently published USEF/WDAA Western Dressage tests will be used for the Western Dressage TOC class and are available at https://westerndressageassociation.org/wdaa-tests/. 2018 USEA Eventing Dressage tests will be used for the Eventing Dressage TOC class and are available at https://useventing.com/events-competitions/resources/dressage-tests.
- 5. MAIDEN RIDER classes are open to riders who have never won a blue ribbon at the specified level at an USEF, USDF, or MHSA recognized show. MAIDEN HORSE classes are open to horses who have never won a blue ribbon at the specified level at a USEF, USDF, or MHSA recognized show.
- 6. In call TOC classes (118, 119, 120, 121, 122, 218, 219, 220, 221, 222) more than one test may be ridden but each test will carry a separate entry fee. State test(s) to be ridden on entry form. Classes will be split if entries permit.
- 7. All USEF/USDF dressage tests to be ridden in a plain snaffle except at Third Level or above, where full bridle is optional.
- 8. Ribbons through sixth place will be awarded for all classes. High score ribbons will be awarded for highest overall percentage at any level on both Saturday and Sunday.
- 9. A negative Coggins test, dated within one year, must be submitted (copy) with entry. Original Coggins hardcopy must accompany each horse arriving on the grounds.
- 10. **RIDE TIMES:** Email Bailey at <u>bailey.mccallum@williamwoods.edu</u>. Ride times will also be posted on the Facebook Event page.
- 11. No dogs please!
- 12. Light concessions on show grounds; easy access to restaurants in the area.
- 13. NOTE REFUND POLICY: Entries may be cancelled for any reason prior to midnight on the closing date. AFTER MIDNIGHT ON CLOSING DATE REFUNDS ARE POSSIBLE IF YOUR REASON IS COMPELLING!!!

***STABLING** is available on an extremely limited basis, preference given to out-of-town horses. Jump-out is available for no charge. Stabling fee includes all sawdust (not shavings) bedding.

DIRECTIONS: From I-70: Take Highway 54 West (exit 148) for approximately six miles toward Fulton and Jefferson City. Take the second Fulton exit (Route HH) and turn LEFT at the top of the ramp onto William Woods Ave. Follow William Woods Ave. for one mile and bear RIGHT at the "Y" intersection onto Westminster Ave. Turn LEFT onto 13th St. William Woods University stables are on the LEFT.

<u>From Highway 54 South (northbound):</u> Take the third Fulton exit (route HH) and turn RIGHT onto William Woods Ave. Follow directions as above.
